PRODUCT USAGE:

Shaklee **Basic-G** is recommended for use in schools, colleges, daycares, office buildings, commercial and industrial institutions, hotels and motels, and households. Shaklee **Basic-G** disinfects, cleans, and deodorizes the following hard non-porous inanimate surfaces: floors, walls, metal surfaces, stainless steel surfaces, glazed porcelain, plastic surfaces (such as polypropylene, polystyrene, etc.). Also use Shaklee **Basic-G** on mildew stains in damp areas such as bathrooms, showers, kitchens, basements and laundry rooms.

General Use Directions for Disinfecting and Mould/Mildew Control:

Before use of this product, all food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or protected. Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits then thoroughly wet surfaces. Use 3.9 mL per litre of water (1:256; 600 ppm quat) for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. Can be applied with a mop, sponge, cloth, coarse spray or by soaking.

The recommended use solution is prepared fresh for each use then discarded. All food contact surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water after disinfection. All surfaces and objects that may come in contact with children at the mouthing stage must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water after disinfection. Rinsing of floors is not necessary unless floors are to be waxed or polished. For mould and mildew control, repeat application weekly or when growth reappears.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. DANGER - CORROSIVE TO EYES AND SKIN. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. To protect eyes, wear goggles or face shield; to protect skin, wear chemical-resistant gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician or poison control centre immediately. Take container, label or product name and product registration number with you when seeking medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DISPOSAL:

Rinse the empty container. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on spills, and for clean up of spills or the disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the manufacturer.
